With a remarkable 46 years of service for Goodwill's mission, Denise Krug will retire next month.

Denise led the creation of Goodwill's Possibilities program, the first-of-its-kind in the nation 14,000 square-foot simulated community using an experiential, proven learning model that engages participants who have physical or developmental disabilities.

Denise was instrumental in introducing our LIFT IT program and expanding BankWork\$ and English as a Second Language trainings. She was also successful in acquiring contracts including Colorado Department of Transportation in Golden and the Denver County Temporary Assistance for Needy Families program. Her impact in the mission arena has been remarkable.
